

What to Expect

Each church has its own personality and worship style. We encourage you to join us in worship to get to know us better. Here's some information that may help you feel more comfortable before and during your visit. Please contact us if you have questions.

Parking

Three entrances will let you come into our church from either of our parking lots. We have parking lots on either the north or south side of the church; the accessible entrance is located on the south side of the church. The elevator there will take you to the sanctuary or to the fellowship hall and restrooms.

Attire

Some of our worshipers prefer more dressy attire, others more casual. The choice is yours.

Worship

Our Saturday 5:30 worship uses a variety of instruments and music styles, led by a vocal group called the Celebration Singers, with the primary instruments being piano or guitar. The atmosphere is more relaxed.

Our Sunday 9:30 am worship uses a variety of music styles and instruments, led by St John's Choir, with the primary instrument being organ.

We'd love to know you were a guest at our church. At some point in the worship a black binder may be passed for you to sign. Both members and guests are encouraged to sign the welcome to worship sheet and place it in the offering plate when it is passed. As our guest, we acknowledge your presence as your gift.

Our services include traditional and contemporary liturgies and music.

When you arrive, an usher will give you a weekly bulletin that includes an outline of the service, and the latest announcements.

Holy Communion

At St John all are welcome to the Lord's Table for communion, including children. If you choose not to take communion, you may come forward for a blessing or remain in your seat. Those communing will come forward, receive bread and choice of wine or grape juice, then return to their seats. The worship leader will give instructions during the service.
